

## The Singing Angels Fundraising Policy

There have been inquiries by Parents as to what types of fundraising activities can be conducted for the benefit of their child to go on tour or special trips that may occur from time to time.

An individual parent may conduct an individual fundraising effort for the purpose of raising funds for the benefit of their child pursuant to the following:

- It must be clear the gift of money does not benefit The Singing Angels
- It must be clear the funds given are for the sole benefit of the child being solicited for
- The funds given to the parent or child are not tax deductible
- Any checks should be made payable to the family and not to The Singing Angels, any checks erroneously made payable to The Singing Angels will be returned
- The Angel may wear their uniform to assist with the fundraising effort
- Any group fundraising effort (group meaning two or more Angel families) that wishes to organize a fundraising event (of any kind being promoted to the public, like a car wash) must have prior written permission by Executive Director of The Singing Angels. In such cases the event organizers will need to submit in writing the nature of the event and the planned use of the Singing Angel name.
- No individual parent or group of parents, are permitted to solicit funds from organizations, businesses, or corporations for any purpose without the express written permission of The Singing Angels. TSA, has ongoing fundraising efforts with organizations, businesses, corporations, and individuals and it is our goal not to send confusing or mixed messages to these stakeholders.
